

Title I Policy Statement:

Jonesport Elementary School, in accordance with Union 103's Title I Parent Involvement policy (KBF), encourages parental involvement in all school activities and programs to promote successful school experiences for parents and students.

Home-School Compact:

In the fall of each year, the home-school compact is explained to all parents. A copy is sent home to parents of students who received Title I services in the previous year and will continue to be supported. The Home-School Compact explains the role of the each team member – the classroom and Title I teacher, child, and family – in the success of the intervention. The brochure also explains Title I eligibility, provides contact information, lists parent / school communication, and invites parents to be involved in the Comprehensive Needs Assessment Process.

Open House / Annual Meeting

A presentation is made by the ESEA coordinator each year at the open house. A sign-in sheet is used to record attendance. The ESEA coordinator shares about Title I services, eligibility, program formats, and referral. The Home-School Compact is also explained and information is shared about the school goals and use of ESEA funds for the year.

Communication

For students continuing in Title I, a letter and copy of the Home-School Compact is sent home at the beginning of the school year. When new students are referred for Title I, a notification letter and a copy of the Home-School Compact are sent home. A referral form is also completed by the classroom teacher. Parents of Title I students receive quarterly progress reports. Title I personnel meet with parents during the fall and spring parent teacher conferences. All communication includes contact information and parents are often invited to contact the school or come in to observe the program. Teachers keep more frequent communication with parents through book packets and homework logs. For students who also receive Special Education services, the Title I teacher will attend IEP meetings. At the end of each school year, parents of Title I students are invited to provide feedback about the program.

Special Events

In conjunction with the annual curriculum fair, Title I families receive a special invitation to stop by the Title I classroom. Students receive their Title I literacy and math summer packs. They also have the opportunity to show off some of their work and showcase some activities they engage in.



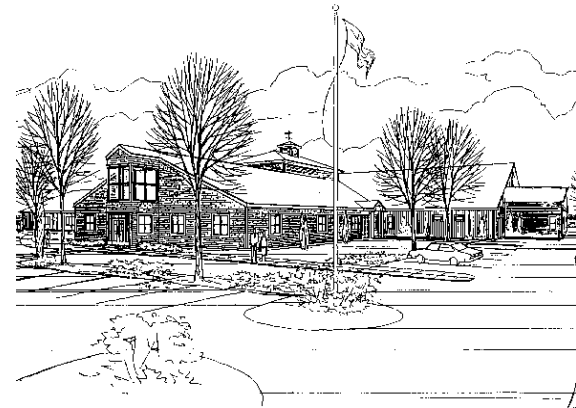
