

ISSUES FOR REOPENING OF SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER

There are several possibilities being considered for a safe return to classroom instruction. These include:

1. Six feet distancing as required by State mandate: what does that look like on the bus, in the school, in the classroom?
2. Wearing masks- everyone including the students, staff and visitors- this may be a State requirement but we're not sure yet
3. Touchless temperature kiosks: We may be installing these in all three schools to check temperatures before entry- a high temperature could preclude entry
4. Recess may look quite different with six foot distancing
5. Lunch may be served in the classroom instead of the cafeteria
6. Some staff or students may have medical conditions that put them at very high risk for exposure to COVID-19. They may need to participate remotely
7. We may need to remove items from the classroom that cannot be sanitized daily such as toys, rugs, various equipment
